

ALASKA COURT SYSTEM

FILING & OTHER FEE INCREASES

◆ *Effective January 1, 2018* ◆

Changes include:

Supreme Court & Court of Appeals

- Filing notice of appeal or cross-appeal \$250.00
- Filing petition for review or cross-petition for review \$250.00
- Filing original proceedings \$250.00
- Filing petition for hearing \$250.00
- Preparation of case record for review by the Supreme Court of the United States \$200.00
- Copies of court opinions, per opinion \$ 5.00

Superior Court

- Filing any civil case, including petition for deposition before action \$250.00
- Motion to modify child custody, visitation, or support or spousal maintenance or property division \$ 75.00
- Filing a trust or estate action \$250.00
- Filing a probate petition for approval of minor settlement \$100.00
- Filing a guardianship, conservatorship, or other protective proceeding (not including filings under AS 13.26.207-209 or for involuntary commitment) \$150.00
- Filing an appeal or petition for review from district court \$250.00
- Except for any similar appeal from small claims court \$100.00
- Filing an action to enjoin or enforce orders of the Alaska Worker's Compensation Board \$250.00
- Filing an appeal or petition for review from an administrative order \$250.00
- Filing a petition for change of name \$200.00

District Court

- Filing fees, district court jurisdiction (not small claims) \$150.00

Other fee changes

- Copy fees per document(s) \$5/first, \$3/additional
- Certified copy of a document \$10/first, \$3/additional
